Where To Go

If you plan to drive, there is free garage parking available at 52 Oxford St.

Driving directions are available here:
From points North
From points South
From points West
From Logan Airport

Note: The JFK Street bridge is currently under construction. We recommend avoiding it if possible.

If you're arriving via the MBTA (subway), take the Red Line to Harvard Station, then follow these directions.

Taxis are available throughout the city. A taxi ride from the airport will take 20-30 minutes depending on traffic, and cost approx. \$35-40.

Where To Stay

We have a block of rooms available at the Boston Marriott Cambridge on the nights of February 27th, February 28th, and March 1. The hotel is 2 miles from the conference, located by the Kendall MBTA Station (2 stops from Harvard). Rooms are available for \$149/night (excluding tax).
